Each miniature is driven by a figurine, either adult or child according to an original picture.

As for an adult model, the details are reproduced as finely and accurately as possible.









This collection project comes from far away since Benoît remembers participating in the criterium of the Young Pilots when he was a child. And it has been updated with the "Little Big Mans" race, which was brought up to date during the Le Mans Classic.

This new range of models and figurines is at the crossroads of all our know-how; reproduction in scale models of cars and figurines in polyurethan resin.

These are racing models or road versions that were either manufactured by the car manufacturers themselves (ex the Alpine A220) or by craftsmen (Ferrari 275P) for the pleasure of young and old.






